NOTICE: THIS IS A LEGALLY BINDING AGREEMENT. Read this document carefully and in entirety. By signing this agreement, you give up your right and the named minor's right to bring a court action to recover compensation or obtain any other remedy for any personal injury or property damage however caused arising out of the named minor's participation in the Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County Programs, now or any time in the future.

I, the parent/guardian of the minor child on this application, for ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, hereby release, waive, acquit and forever discharge the Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County, and Boys & Girls Clubs of America, their representatives, successors, insurers, assigns or any other person or entity associated with any of the above organizations such as staff, directors or volunteers, from all liability, claims, demands, or causes of action for any and all loss, damage, injury or death and any claim of damages resulting from use of facilities owned or controlled by the above organizations, or participation in activities of said organizations either at or away from the Club.

Acknowledgment of Risk

I, in my legal capacity as the parent/guardian of the minor named below, do hereby acknowledge and agree that participation in Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County activities comes with inherent risks. I have full knowledge and understanding of the inherent risks associated with Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County participation, including but in no way limited to: (1) slips, trips, and falls, (2) aquatic injuries, (3) athletic injuries, and (4) illness, including exposure to and infection with viruses or bacteria. I further acknowledge that the preceding list is not inclusive of all possible risks associated with Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County participation and that said list in no way limits the operation of this Agreement.

TECHNOLOGY

Initial

As a member of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County, your child will have access to the Internet. While precautions are being taken, it is possible that he/she may access inappropriate sites. Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County will have rules and consequences at the club for such behavior; however, we will not be responsible for the consequences of such access.

ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION DEVICES

Initial

The Boys and Girls Clubs of Saline County realizes the impact technology can have on a member's education. If used correctly, it can broaden a member's ability to find and retrieve valuable information. As an educational tool, we welcome the opportunity to extend our members' knowledge base by allowing electronic communication devices in the building. Members are responsible for conducting themselves in a manner that respects the rights of others. Possession and use of any electronic device, whether club or member owned, that interferes with a positive, orderly classroom environment does not respect the rights of others and is expressly forbidden.

- Electronic devices and accessories must be turned on silent and put away before entering the building. Members may resume use of the electronic device at the end of the programmatic day.

- Members are not allowed the use of electronic devices (cell phones, laptop computers, iPads, Nooks, smart watches, etc.) during programmatic hours in any manner other than specifically permitted by the full-time staff. When permission is granted, the device must be turned on silent and only one earpiece may be used.
- Electronic devices must be turned on silent while members are in program hours during the programmatic day unless permission has been granted by the staff for instructional use. Noises (rings, alarms, text notifications, etc.) from electronic devices that interrupt programs will not be tolerated.
- Unless instructed by a full-time staff, when in a classroom or an assembly during the programmatic day, electronic devices must be put away.
- Members are not allowed to send or receive personal calls, emails, or texts at any time throughout the programmatic day unless they have permission from the Club Director. If it is an emergency and you need to get a hold of your child, call the club phone.
- Members are not allowed to engage in any dishonesty regarding any electronic devices.
- Unless the member is under the direct supervision of a staff member, at no time is a member allowed to video tape, audio tape, or take pictures of another person or pose for pictures being taken;
- Violations include, but are not limited to any of the above. Violations can result in a minimum of the following consequences:

Consequences can range from a Conference to Suspension. At no time should a cell phone or other electronic device be used as a means of cyber- bullying or the harassment of any member or staff member. Violations of harassment or bullying with any electronic device can result in consequences ranging from conference to suspension

Members are not allowed to create, send, share, view, receive, or possess an indecent visual depiction of oneself or another person. Violations can result in consequences ranging from conference to suspension.

Members have no right to privacy as to the content contained on any electronic device that has been confiscated.

While members are welcome to bring their own cell phone, the Boys and Girls Clubs of Saline County, nor any employee, is responsible for any member owned electronic device that is lost, stolen, or damaged. The Boys and Girls Clubs of Saline County will not be responsible for any costs incurred for data usage.

As used in this policy, "electronic devices" means anything that can be used to transmit or capture images, sound, or data.

If an electronic device is removed from a member for disciplinary action, the device must be picked up from the club by a parent.

LATE PICKUP FEE

Initial

Please make sure Club Members are picked up prior to the posted pick up times. Five (5) minutes following the closing time of the Club, a \$5.00 late fee will be due. There will be an additional \$1.00 per minute charged for each minute the parent/guardian is late in picking up their child. This is a per child fee. These fees are necessary due to the additional costs sustained by the Club. The Club reserves the right to contact the appropriate authorities which include the local police department and Department of Family Protective Services for assistance when members are not picked up within a reasonable amount of time (within 30 minutes) following closing time. Parents, if unforeseen circumstances occur and you find you are going to be late picking up your child, please call the Club. Staff members will make every effort to work with you.

MISCELLANEOUS

I understand that the Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County is a drop-in facility, not a licensed day care. The Club operates under the open-door policy and assumes no responsibility for the time or manner in which members arrive at or leave from the Boys & Girls Club property. Parents who wish a member to remain on the property must work this out with their child.

I give permission for my child's picture, moving pictures, or any other graphic depiction or likeness, to be used by the Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County and its activities.

I give permission for my child to participate in volunteer activities, including but not limited to cleaning, sweeping, data entry, working with staff or other members/volunteers.

The Club respects the rights of its members against arbitrary intrusion of their person or property. At the same time, it is the responsibility of Club staff to protect the health, safety and welfare of all members & visitors. We reserve the right to inspect and/or search members and/or their property when there is reasonable suspicion to believe such member or property contains stolen, illegal or other items in violation of the law or club rules. Club authorities may seize evidence found in the search and appropriate disciplinary action may be taken.

Waiver, Release, Indemnification & Covenant Not to Sue

In consideration of _____'s participation in Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County, I, _____, the parent/guardian of the minor named above, agree to release and on behalf of myself and the minor named above, my heirs, representatives, executors, administrators, and assigns, HEREBY DO RELEASE Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers, agents, representatives and insurers ("Releasees") from any causes of action, claims, or demands of any nature whatsoever including, but in no way limited to, claims of negligence, which I, the named minor, my heirs, representatives, executors, administrators and assigns and the named minor's heirs representatives, executors, administrators and assigns may have, now or in the future, against Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County on account of personal injury, property damage, death or accident of any kind, arising out of or in any way related to the use of Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County facilities/equipment or participation in Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County programs whether that participation is supervised or unsupervised, however the injury or damage occurs, including, but not limited to the negligence of Releasees.

In consideration of the named minor's participation in Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County, I, the undersigned parent/guardian of the named minor, agree to INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS Releasees from any and all causes of action, claims, demands, losses, or costs of any nature whatsoever arising out of or in any way related to the named minor's Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County participation.

I hereby certify on behalf of myself and the named minor that I have full knowledge of the nature and extent of the risks inherent in Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County participation and that I, on behalf of myself and the named minor, am voluntarily assuming said risks. I understand that I and the named minor will be solely responsible for any loss or damage, including personal injury, property damage, or death, the named minor sustains while participating in Boys & Girls Clubs of Saline County and that by signing this agreement I, on behalf of myself and the named minor, HEREBY RELEASE Releasees of all liability for such loss, damage, or death.
