Applicant must be seeking a degree in Construction, Architectural Design or Engineering.

Charles P. Phillips came to Benton, Arkansas in the late 1960's. As a businessman, builder and land developer it didn't take him long to get involved in the community he learned to love and respect so very much.

In the early 1970's Mr. Phillips along with several other businessmen of the community helped to construct the Boys & Girls Club we are in today.

Mr. Phillips was always helping out with local activities and projects in Saline County, especially ones that had to do with children. He was a volunteer basketball coach at the Boys and Girls Club and helped with renovations of several program areas where children were participants.

Mr. Phillips built over 1,000 homes in 25 subdivisions in Saline County. You can easily look back at his accomplishments and certainly see why as early as the 1980's he was voted Citizen of the Year. It is because he gave so much of himself to make changes in our community and the lives of the children here that we want to give back to honor him; a scholarship in his memory.

Criteria for Application and Submission Check Off List

- Applicant must be a resident of Saline County and a graduating high school senior that will be a first generation college student entering their freshman year.*

- Applicant must have at least a 2.0 GPA.

- Applicant must ***personally*** complete the Charles P. Phillips Memorial application with signature, and provide all the necessary documentation. All requested information must be sent in the application packet – individual pieces of information will not be accepted.

- Applicant must submit a recent photograph with application.

- Applicant must submit a copy of his/her High School transcript.

- Applicant must submit a 100 word or less, essay concerning the impact this scholarship will have on their educational future. Applications with essays in excess of 100 words will be automatically disqualified.

- Applicant must submit two (2) letters of recommendations. Preferences are: one from either an Instructor or Counselor from the High School you are attending; and one from a community leader. However, both may come for your High School. The letters must be signed by the person making the recommendation. ***No electronic signatures will be accepted.***

- The Scholarship Committee will conduct personal interviews with the finalists. The time and date will be announced.
