Frank “Corky” Chenault served as Superintendent of the Benton Public Schools (1986-1999). Prior to his administrative role, Corky was a Teacher and Coach. “Corky” loved kids and placed a high emphasis on the value of education and community involvement.

“Corky” served on the Board of the Boys & Girls Club of Saline County (2007-2014). He also served as a volunteer coach from 1976-1983. Corky chaired the payroll deduction program in which employees of the Benton School District could donate a portion of their monthly income to further educational opportunities for kids in need. This program continues to raise money for the Boys and Girls Club after-school educational programs

Frank was loved by many, but mostly by his wife Linda Jo Chenault and his three children: Karen Stout, Karla Neathery, and Greg Chenault.

Criteria for Application and Submission Check Off List

- Applicant must be a graduating senior from Benton high School, entering their freshman year of College.
- Applicant must have at least a 2.5 GPA.
- Applicant must **personally** complete the Frank “Corky” Chenault application with signature, and provide all the necessary documentation. All requested information must be sent in the application packet – individual pieces of information will not be accepted.
- Applicant must submit a recent photograph with application.
- Applicant must submit a copy of his/her Benton High School transcript.
- Applicant must submit a **100 word or less**, essay concerning the impact this scholarship will have on their educational future. Applications with essays in excess of 100 words will be automatically disqualified.
- Applicant must submit two (2) letters of recommendations. Preferences are: one from either an Instructor or Counselor from Benton High School; and one from a community leader. The letters must be signed by the person making the recommendation. **No electronic signatures will be accepted.**
- Applicant must be or have been a Club member or has played a sport through the Boys & Girls Club of Saline County.
- The Scholarship Committee may conduct personal interviews with the finalists. The time and date will be discussed.
